5	Achievements of the Working Group in 2017 (250 words)	The working group had made a call to evaluate new diagnostic tests and validate existing tests. Following this we have: Evaluated the utility of IgE (total and A. fumigatus specific) in monitoring for response and exacerbations in allergic bronchopulmonary aspergillosis. In this study, the sensitivity and specificity of A. fumigatus-specific IgG in diagnosis of ABPA was 89% and 100%, respectively. In contrast, the sensitivity of Aspergillus precipitins was only 27.4%. Following treatment, the A. fumigatus-specific IgG increased in 38 (37.2%) subjects, while it decreased in three (23.1%) of the 13 subjects experiencing an exacerbation.
