4. Objectives and expected outcomes for the forthcoming year

The objective of this year is to perform the pilot project comparing the performances of different SNP genotyping pipelines for whole genome sequencing analysis of outbreaks. We aim to have at least five groups involved. During this year 2019 we will analyze the data and communicate the results to the participants. A report with the main conclusions will be released for all the working group members and in a second stage after discussion to all ISHAM members.

During 2019 we will draft the manuscript to be submitted to an international journal with the main results of this pilot project.

5. Achievements of the Working Group in 2018 (250 words) 1-3

The working group was officially accepted on March 26th 2018. We set up a working group meeting at the ISHAM conference in Amsterdam on July 2nd 2018 from 9 to 11:30 am. In this meeting, we officially launched the working group giving a short overview of the objectives and opened a round table discussion about challenges/unmet needs of fungal genomic epidemiology with a specific focus on public health. We developed a strategy how to address these needs. We agreed to run a pilot project, in which a set of reads from outbreak isolates will be sent to the participating labs to be analyzed using their favorite tools aimed at estimating of the extent of variability between different methods. By the end of 2018, 12 groups representing 11 institutions from 6 countries agreed to participate in the pilot and by February 2019, 10 groups have submitted results.
